

## **Network Directory of Contract Services**

Region 3 Behavioral Health Services (Region 3) contracts with behavioral health agencies to provide a variety of mental health and substance use disorder services for individuals and families who reside in the twenty-two county area of Region 3. Region 3 also directly provides specialized case management services and housing assistance. Individuals are assessed to ensure they meet clinical criteria, income guidelines (if the specific services require this and income is based on family income), and verification of U.S. citizenship or legal immigration status to receive services. Region 3 also contracts with community coalitions providing prevention services. The services included in this directory are the behavioral health services that Region 3 contracts for and may not include all services provided by the agency.

The **Nebraska Family Helpline** makes it easier for families to obtain assistance by providing a single contact point 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Trained Helpline operators screen calls to assess immediate safety needs, identify the potential level of a behavioral health crisis, make recommendations or referrals to appropriate resources, and help callers connect to emergency resources or providers. The Helpline is supervised by licensed mental health professionals.

Family Helpline operators also can connect eligible families to the **Family Navigator Service**. This service helps families move through Nebraska's child and family-care system more efficiently to get the assistance they need. Available within 24 to 72 hours after a Helpline referral, Family Navigator helps families identify existing community-based services and provides support from people who have had personal experience in the system.
